Mayor William Dickinson called the meeting to order at 12:07.

Action Item #1

Minutes of the May 14, 2014 meeting were adopted on a motion by J. Portley seconded by FS Cosgrove, which passed unanimously.

Action Item #2

J Rode presented a revised TIP Amendment 26 which included 13 projects. After a brief discussion, J. Bodwell made a motion to recommend approval, FS McPherson seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Action Item #3

J Rode reported on the Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Persons With Disabilities program. By the May 16th Deadline for applications the Region had received 8 applications for 10 vehicles and 2 applications for operating funds. A prioritized list was developed using criteria provided by CDOT and was reviewed by the selection committee. Base on the applications submitted and the available funding this list was included in a resolution and recommended for approval by the COG. FS Mazza made a Motion to accept the recommendation, FS McPherson seconded; passed unanimously.

Information Item #4

J Rode gave a brief update Mobility Management Program for the New Haven Region. In response to the RFP for services, SCRCOG received 3 proposals. Consultant interviews were held on June 3rd. A selection committee made up of representatives from Milford Transit, Greater New Haven Transit, Estuary Transit, RiverCOG and CDOT evaluated respondents and recommended the Kennedy Center to provide services.



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Information Item #5

S. Dudley presented an expanded list of projects for the LOTCIP program to include requests that came in during the past month and a possible prioritized list of projects for fiscal years 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019. Those present discussed the lists and made recommendations. R. Hiza discussed the project in Orange. The project is for rebuilding Derby Milford Rd. He encouraged the committee to move the project up in the schedule. It was the recommendation to keep the project in the schedule for FY16.

Information Item #6

S. Dudley presented a draft set of regional guidelines for Rights of Way procedures and asked for comment from those present. There was a brief discussion S. Dudley will continue to work on the guidelines.

J. Portley made a motion to adjourn. FS Mazza seconded, meeting was adjourned at 1:05 PM.

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Resolution

Fiscal Year 2012-Fiscal Year 2015 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment Twenty Seven

Whereas: U.S. Department of Transportation “Metropolitan Planning Regulations” (23 *CFR* 450) prescribe that each metropolitan planning organization maintain a financially constrained multi-modal transportation improvement program consistent with a *State Implementation Plan for Air Quality (SIP)* conforming to both U.S. Environmental Protection Administration-established air quality guidelines and *SIP*-established mobile source emissions budgets; and

Whereas: The Council, per 23 *CFR* 450.324 and in cooperation with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) and public transit operators and relying upon financial constraints offered by ConnDOT, adopted a *Fiscal Year 2012-Fiscal Year 2015 Transportation Improvement Program* on January 25, 2012, after finding the *Program* conforming per U.S. Environmental Protection Administration (U.S. EPA) final conformity rule (40 *CFR* 51 and 93) and relevant Connecticut Department of Transportation air quality conformity determinations: *Air Quality Conformity Reports: Fiscal Year 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program* and the Region’s *Long-Range Transportation Plans—2011 to 2040, (April, 2011)*; and

Whereas: The Council, on January 25, 2012, indicated that periodic *Program* adjustment or amendment was possible; and

Whereas: Projects referenced in the *Program* amendment (below) are consistent with the region’s long-range transportation plan (*South Central Regional Long Range Transportation Plan—2011 to 2040, (April, 2011)*); and

Whereas: Council *Public Participation Guidelines: Transportation Planning* have been observed during the development of the proposed *Program* amendment (below); and

Whereas: By agreement between the Council and the Connecticut Department of Transportation, public involvement activities carried out by the South Central Regional Council of Governments in response to U.S. Department of Transportation metropolitan planning requirements are intended to satisfy the requirements associated with development of a *Statewide Transportation Improvement Program* and/or its amendment; and

Whereas: Council of Governments’ review of transportation goals, projects and opportunities may result in further adjustment or amendment of the *Program*.
