Action Item #1: Meeting Minutes of October 9, 2019

J Plaziak made a motion to approve the Minutes of the October 9, 2019 meeting K Weiss seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Action Item #2 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment 18

J. Rode introduced Amendment 18, which included 4 projects. Following a brief discussion FS Cosgrove made a motion to recommend approval of Amendment 18 G Pidluski seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Information Item #3: Discussion of The Regional Transportation Safety Plan.

S. Dudley provided an update on the Regional Safety Plan and the inclusion of local roads. The Committee had requested the removal of local roads from the report. CTDOT has countered that a large percentage of accidents occur on local roads and should therefore be included. Also discussed was concerns of liability issues and if there would be any funding for safety on local roads. S Dudley reported that CTDOT will continue to discussions internally and contact the region sometime after January 1st.

Information Item #4: New Haven-Meriden STP-Urban Program and LOTCIP

S. Dudley reminded those present to get their LOTCIP applications completed so that they can be submitted to CTDOT.

***Fiscal Year 2018-Fiscal Year 2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment
Nineteen***

Whereas: U.S. Department of Transportation “Metropolitan Planning Regulations” (23 *CFR* 450) prescribe that each metropolitan planning organization maintain a financially constrained multi-modal transportation improvement program consistent with a *State Implementation Plan for Air Quality (SIP)* conforming to both U.S. Environmental Protection Administration-established air quality guidelines and *SIP*-established mobile source emissions budgets; and

Whereas: The Council, per 23 *CFR* 450.324 and in cooperation with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) and public transit operators and relying upon financial constraints offered by ConnDOT, adopted a *Fiscal Year 2018-Fiscal Year 2021 Transportation Improvement Program* on July 26, 2017, after finding the *Program* conforming per U.S. Environmental Protection Administration (U.S. EPA) final conformity rule (40 *CFR* 51 and 93) and relevant Connecticut Department of Transportation air quality conformity determinations: *Air Quality Conformity Reports: Fiscal Year 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program* and the Region’s *Metropolitan Transportation Plans—2019 to 2045, (April, 2019)*; and

Whereas: The Council, on *July 26, 2017*, indicated that periodic *Program* adjustment or amendment was possible; and

Whereas: Projects referenced in the *Program* amendment (below) are consistent with the region’s long-range transportation plan (*South Central Regional Metropolitan Transportation Plan—2019 to 2045, (April, 2019)*); and

Whereas: Council *Public Participation Guidelines: Transportation Planning* have been observed during the development of the proposed *Program* amendment (below); and

Whereas: By agreement between the Council and the Connecticut Department of Transportation, public involvement activities carried out by the South Central Regional Council of Governments in response to U.S. Department of Transportation metropolitan planning requirements are intended to satisfy the requirements associated with development of a *Statewide Transportation Improvement Program* and/or its amendment; and

Whereas: Council of Governments’ review of transportation goals, projects and opportunities may result in further adjustment or amendment of the *Program*.
