What We Do

RPC is an advisory commission with a range of responsibilities. Some examples include reviewing amendments to zoning regulations, subdivision applications, and municipal Plans of Conservation and Development (POCD) that a municipality has referred to RPC. Additional items that RPC reviews include Open Space Grant applications and Small Cities Community Development Block Grant applications. RPC is also involved in updating the regional POCD.

SCRCOG staff prepare advisory comments for each referral based on inter-municipal and environmental impacts. Adjacent municipalities are notified of each referral.

Unless otherwise specified, RPC meets on the second Thursday of each month at 5:15 PM.

Statutory Responsibilities

RPC reviews referrals that propose or involve any of the following:

A Zoning Regulation or Map Amendment that affects the use of a zone within 500 feet of another municipality in the region.

An Amendment and/or Update to a municipal Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD).



A Subdivision of Land, which will border or include land in two or more municipalities.



A voluntary RPC review for informational purposes only: an RPC resolution is not necessary.
