**Information Item #3: LOTCIP Project Updates**

The applications were reviewed and comments submitted to the towns. There were two final design submissions reviewed and comments returned. One for L059-002 The Nut Plains Rd and the other for L043-004 East Haven sidewalk phase 5. Finally L079-003 Cedar Street bridge project and L148-002 Northford Road Bridge project both had their Bid openings and are awaiting their notice to proceed.

**Information Item #4: Metropolitan Transportation Plan 2023-2050 Update.**

R. Andreucci spoke about the MTP update. There is an online survey available and there will be 2 public input sessions one virtual meeting on February 2 and one in-person meeting on February 8.

**Program Description**

This JOC program will be administered by CTDOT's Bureau of Highway Operations, which will contract through the CT Department of Administrative Services for the installation of pavement markings on various State roadways, per the Work Plan. Pavement marking types may include, but not limited to, Epoxy Resin, Polyurea, Permanent Tape, and High Build Waterborne. Pavement markings may include long lines, symbols, and legends, along with removal as needed, to maintain the delineation of existing travel lanes and shoulders. Under the JOC delivery method, CTDOT will obtain bids from contractors on an indefinite quantity of work for specific work items, with actual work locations defined by CTDOT during development of individual purchase orders. Four State project numbers are being established, one per District for administrative purposes, with all four State projects under one Federal project #000T(347) and one State "Summary" project DOT01703649SM. All construction and inspection costs (e.g., oversight by State Forces, police services, materials testing) are federally eligible. 100% Federal STPA funds to be budgeted for 2023 construction season with future AC conversions to budget funds for 2024 and 2025 construction seasons.

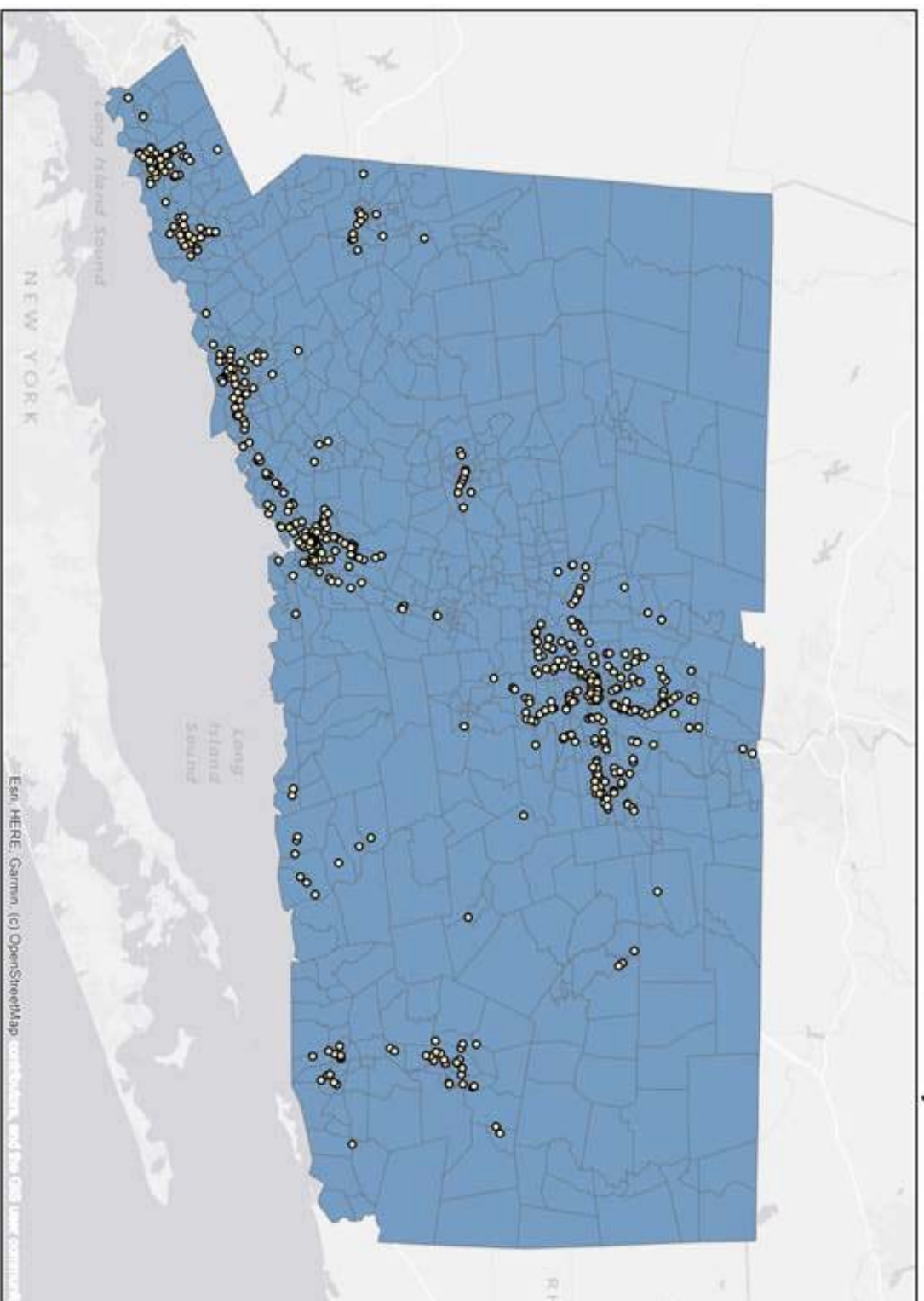

## Introduction

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) directed the operators of CTtransit and requested all Transit Districts in the State to assess the conditions of transit shelters. The purpose of this assessment is to capture existing conditions, establish uniform criteria for evaluation and standards, and prioritize re-investment into transit shelters. This effort will also require continual and evolving methods to maintain and update the inventory. The result of this work should enhance the experience of using transit of customers in the State and streamline investment of state capital funds.

There were a number of entities involved in collecting this data and each have a unique mechanism for maintaining, replacing and funding shelter investments. Maintaining and replacing shelters ranges from state, municipal, private operator and private shelters owner. Any developed plans will consider each unique operating environment and rely on individual's expertise to fully realize the vision of this plan.

The criteria set forth for this data collection included:

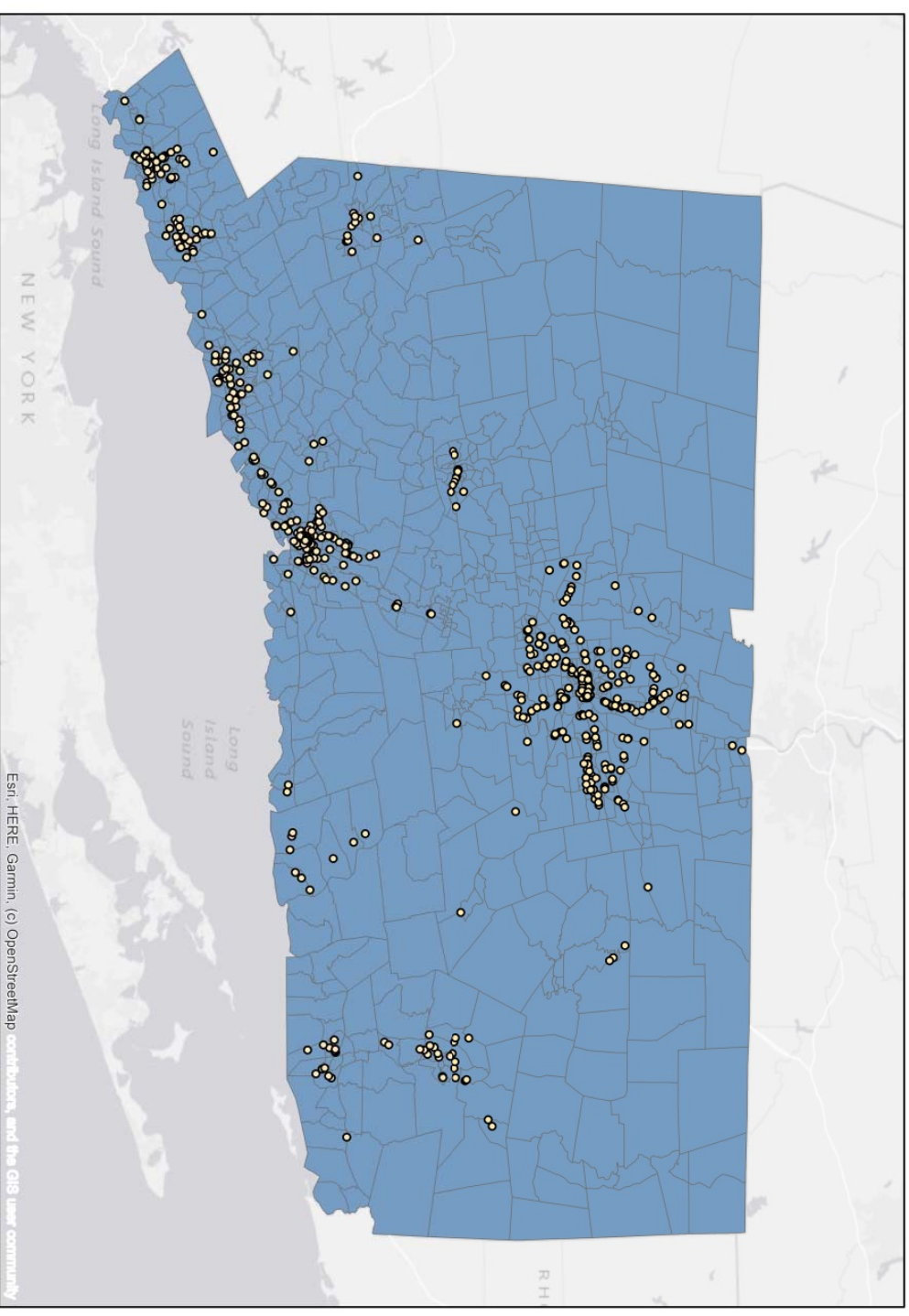
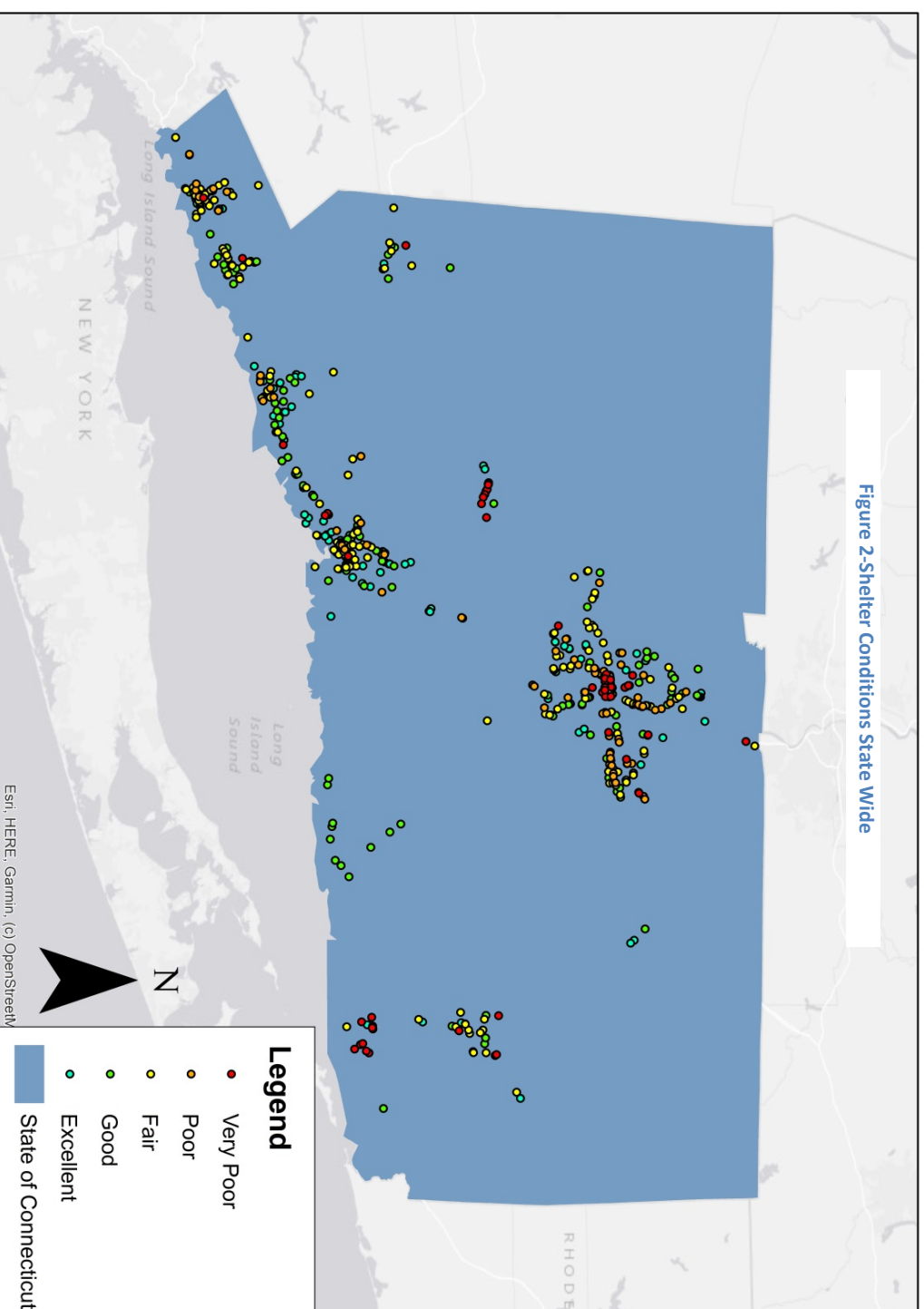


Figure 1-Transit Shelters State Wide

## Data Collection and Condition Assessment

A total of 633 shelters were inspected as part of the statewide assessment. One of the most critical pieces of information gathered during the assessment was the condition of the shelter. These shelters were then placed into five categories: Very Poor, Poor, Fair, Good and Excellent. The condition assessment information will be one of the most important variables in considering investment at specific shelter locations. This investment will consider three possibilities, a complete replacement, repairs as possible or potentially removal of shelter where service guidelines do not warrant the installation.



Analyzing the condition of the shelters across the state some trends can be identified. Generally speaking the shelters near the shoreline from New Haven to New York City tend to be in better condition than those in the Hartford region or to the eastern part of the state. The improved shelter conditions can likely be attributed to the partnership many of the transit districts and entities have with advertising companies. Given the population density, traffic volumes and proximity to New York, these market lend themselves to shelter advertising. In New Haven, the overall improved condition can be attributed to the City having its own Shelter Maintenance crew.

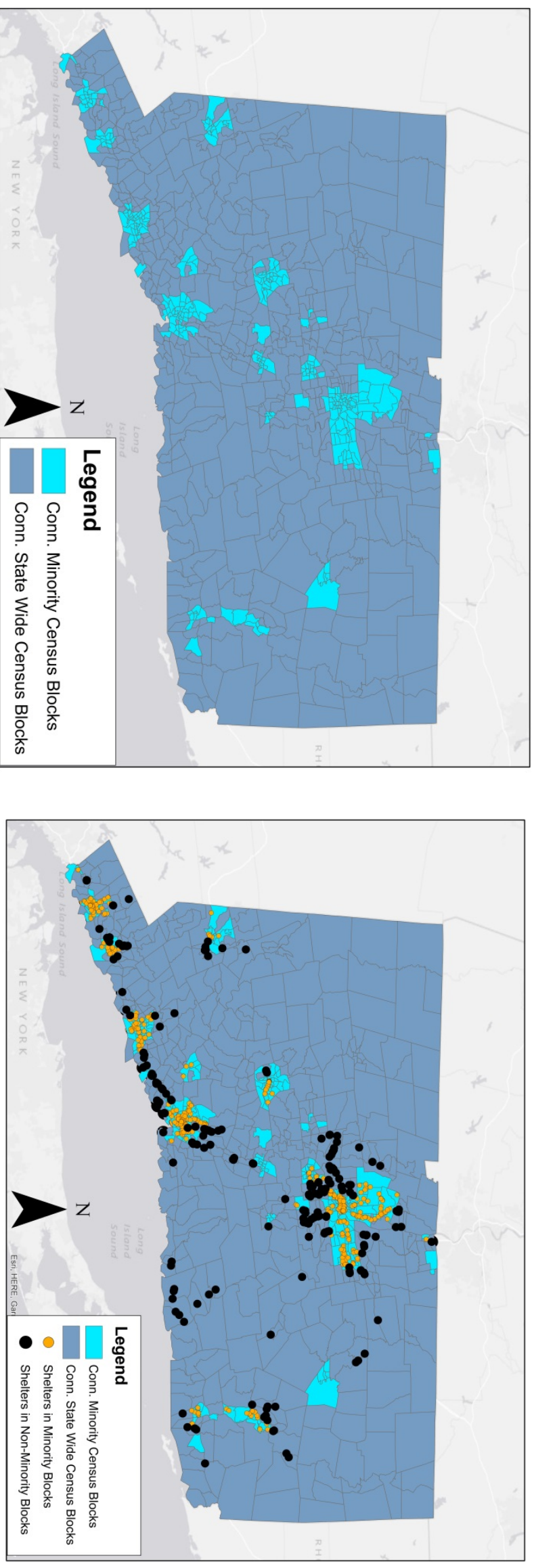

## Minority Blocks

CTDOT has identified areas of minority using the ACS data from 2011 to 2015. This analysis determined that in the state of Connecticut the average minority percentage in census blocks is 32.284%, figure 3 below identifies (shown in light blue) all minority blocks that are above that percentage. The placement of shelters in the state should ensure that there is an equitable distribution of shelter availability in census blocks above that percentage.

Figure 3-Minority Census Blocks and Shelter Placement



Of the 633 shelters in the assessment, 454 were in a minority census block and 179 were out of minority census blocks. This equates to 72% of the total shelter inventory being located in a minority census block statewide. This overwhelming percentage share demonstrates that locations and investment have been equitable. This percentage analysis will be determined at each district and CTransit operator level and will also inform the prioritization of shelter replacement.

## Agency Shelter Overviews

A shelter conditions overview was created for each participating agency. The purpose of this organization is to target the assessment to each region of the state, and provide a baseline to assist in the development of a strategy that can be tailored to the particular geography. Tailoring the assessment is also considerate of the different organization structures (direct recipient vs. operator), funding sources, etc. This summarizes the following:

- Total Number of Shelters
- Total Number of Shelters in Minority Census Blocks
  - Breakdown of total shelters by condition (Very Poor, Poor, Fair, Good, Excellent)
    - Also includes total number and percentage in Minority Census Blocks
- Includes a map of each region that identifies the location of shelters by condition and location of Minority Census Blocks

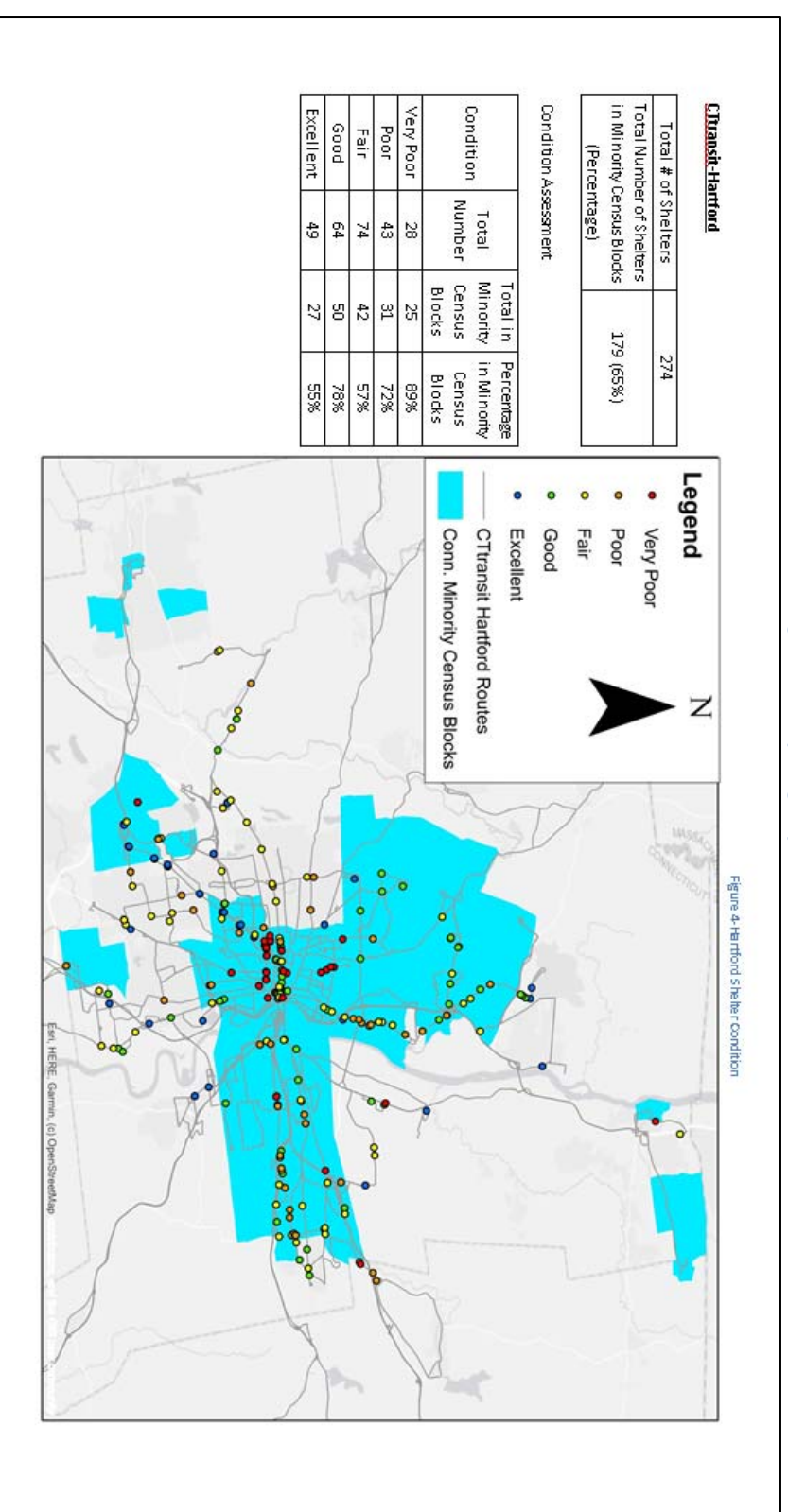


Figure 4-Example Agency Overview

Following the agency is a table that identifies each shelter in the specified region, its condition assessment (1 Very Poor, 2 Poor, 3 Fair, 4 Good, 5 Excellent), who owns the shelter, who maintains the shelter, municipality its located in, latitude/longitude, presence in a minority census block and next steps (Repair/Replace or Inspect in 2021). For some regions such as CTransit Hartford, this table is organized by condition type (Very Poor, Poor, etc.) and requires multiple pages. For other such as Milford a single page sufficed to capture the entirety of the inventory.

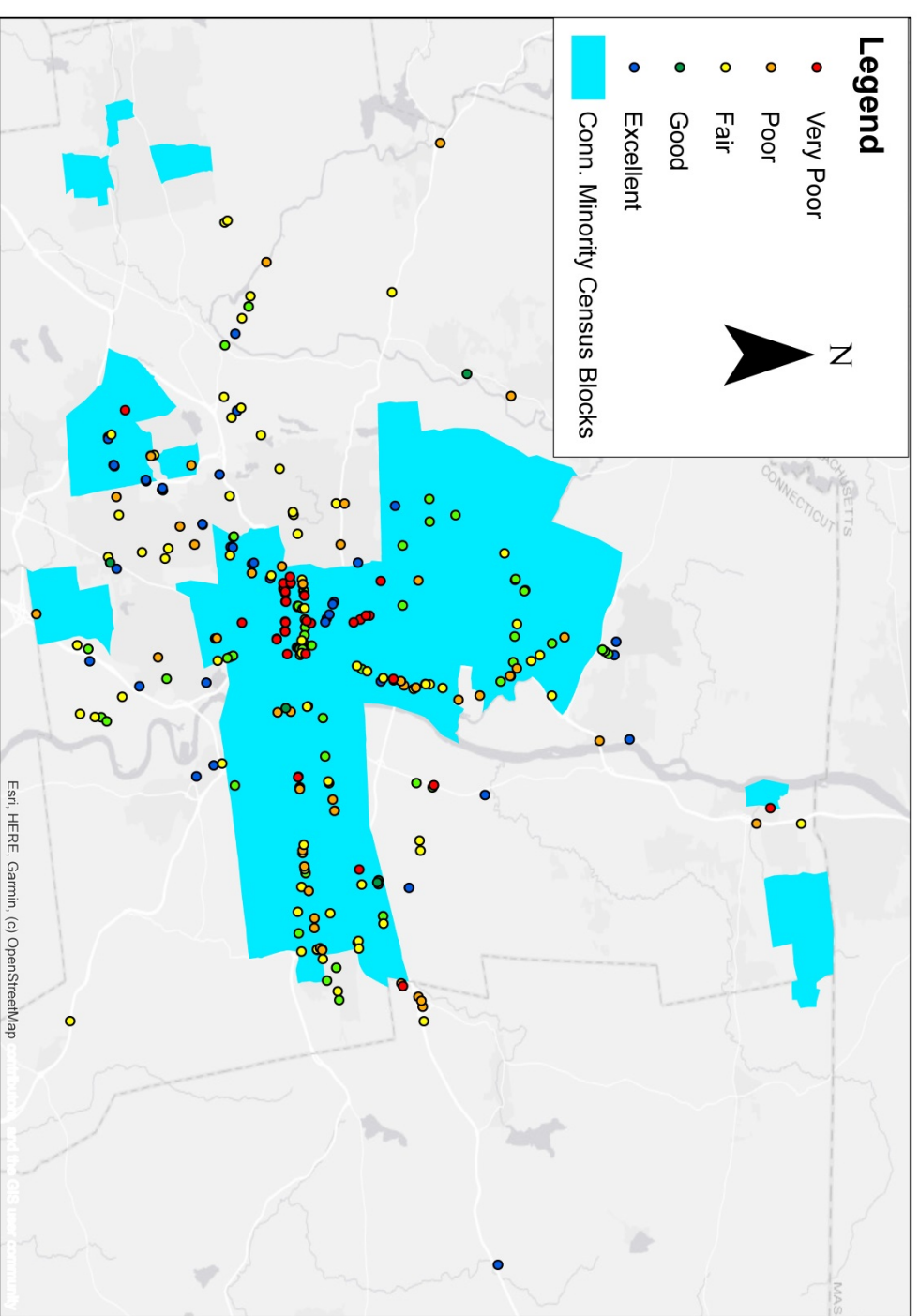


Figure 5-Hartford Shelter Condition

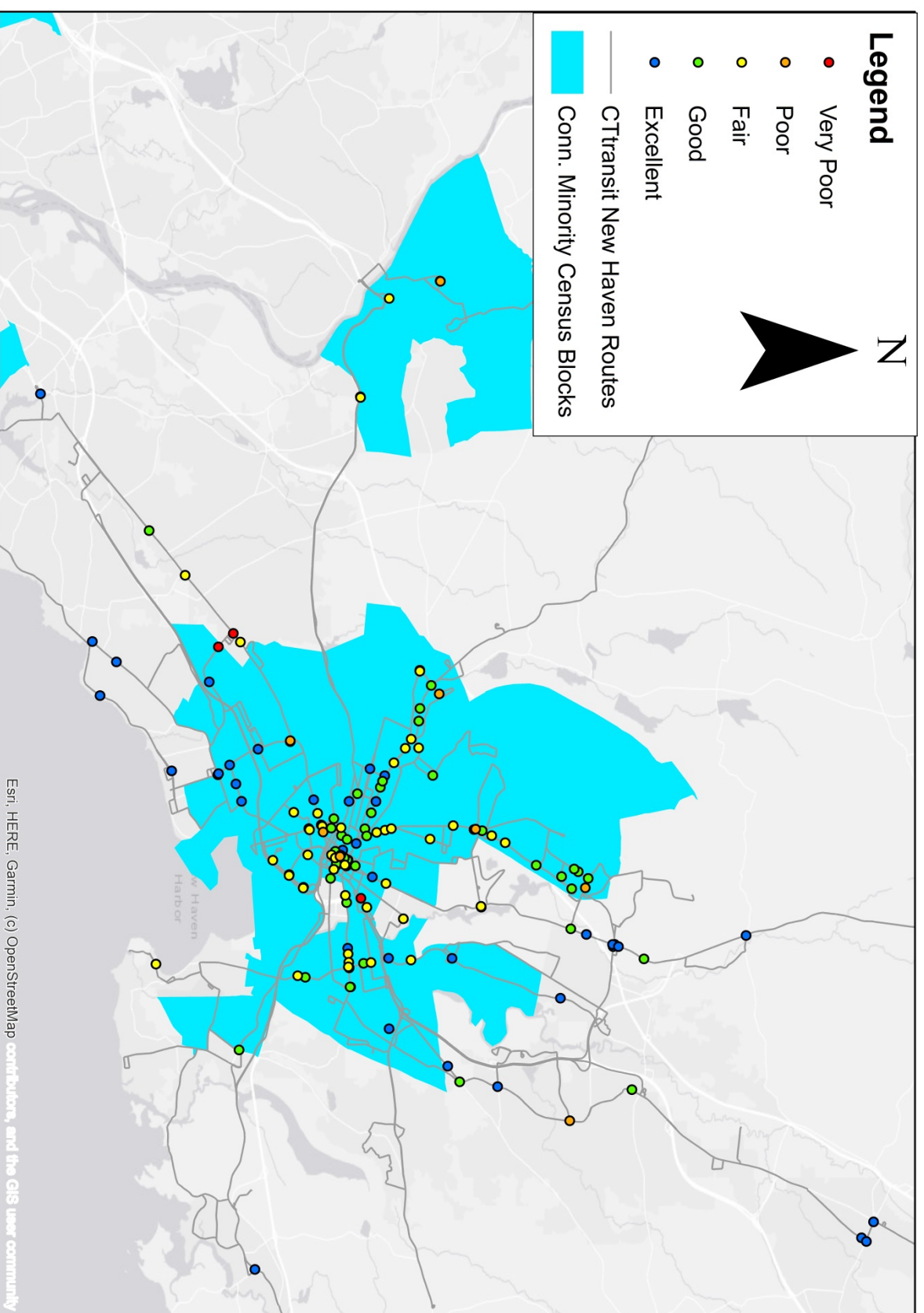


Figure 6-New Haven Shelter Condition

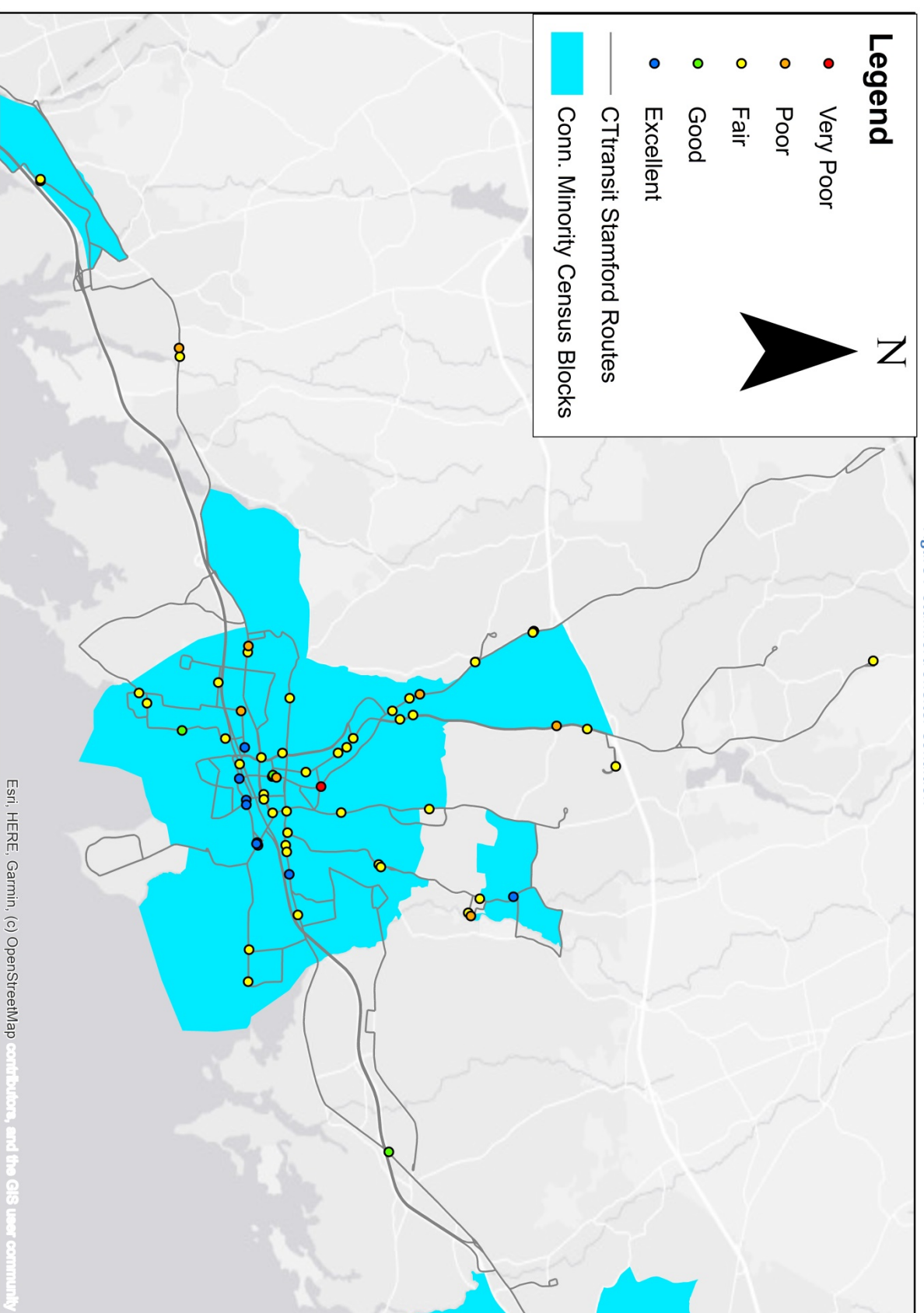

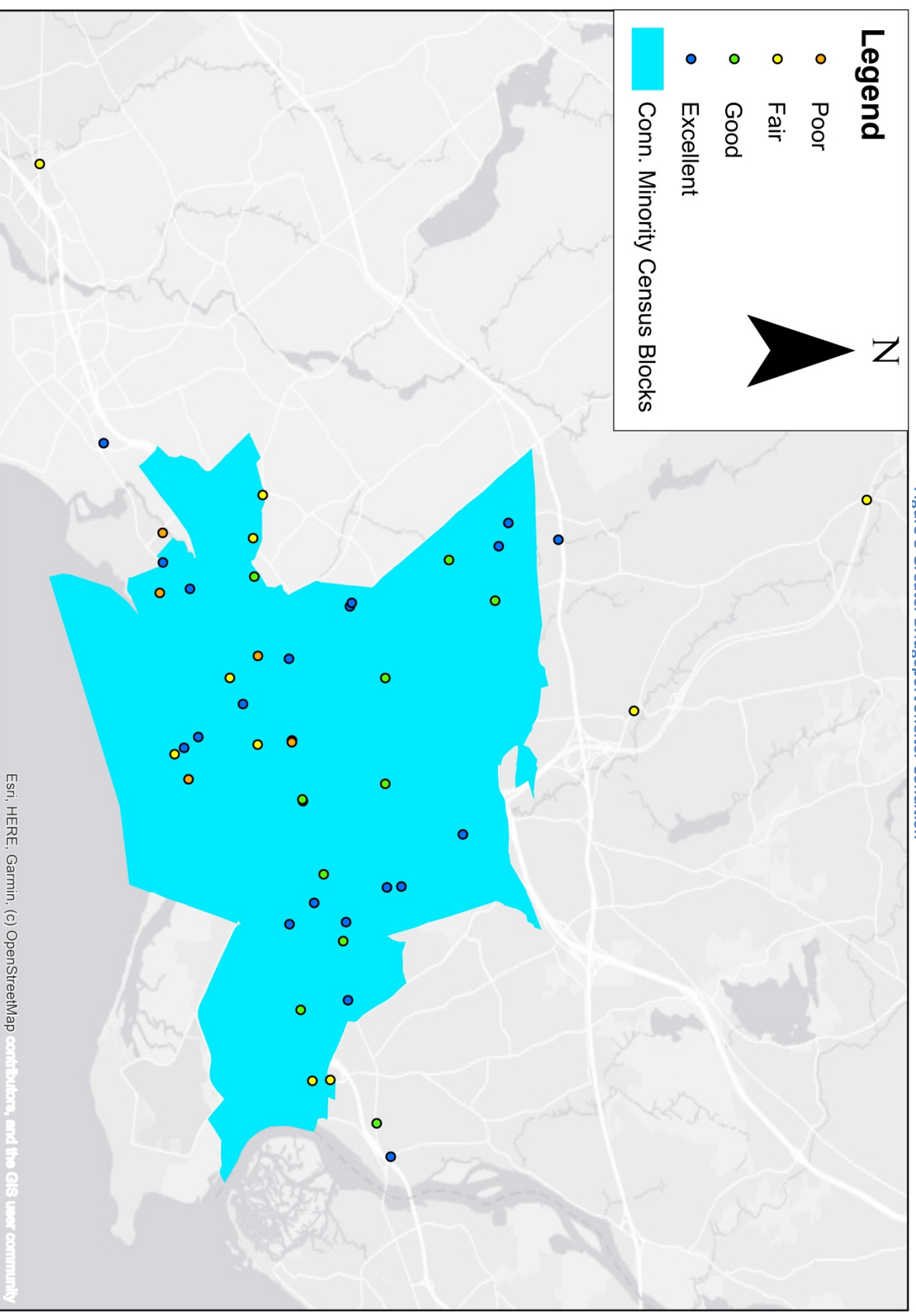

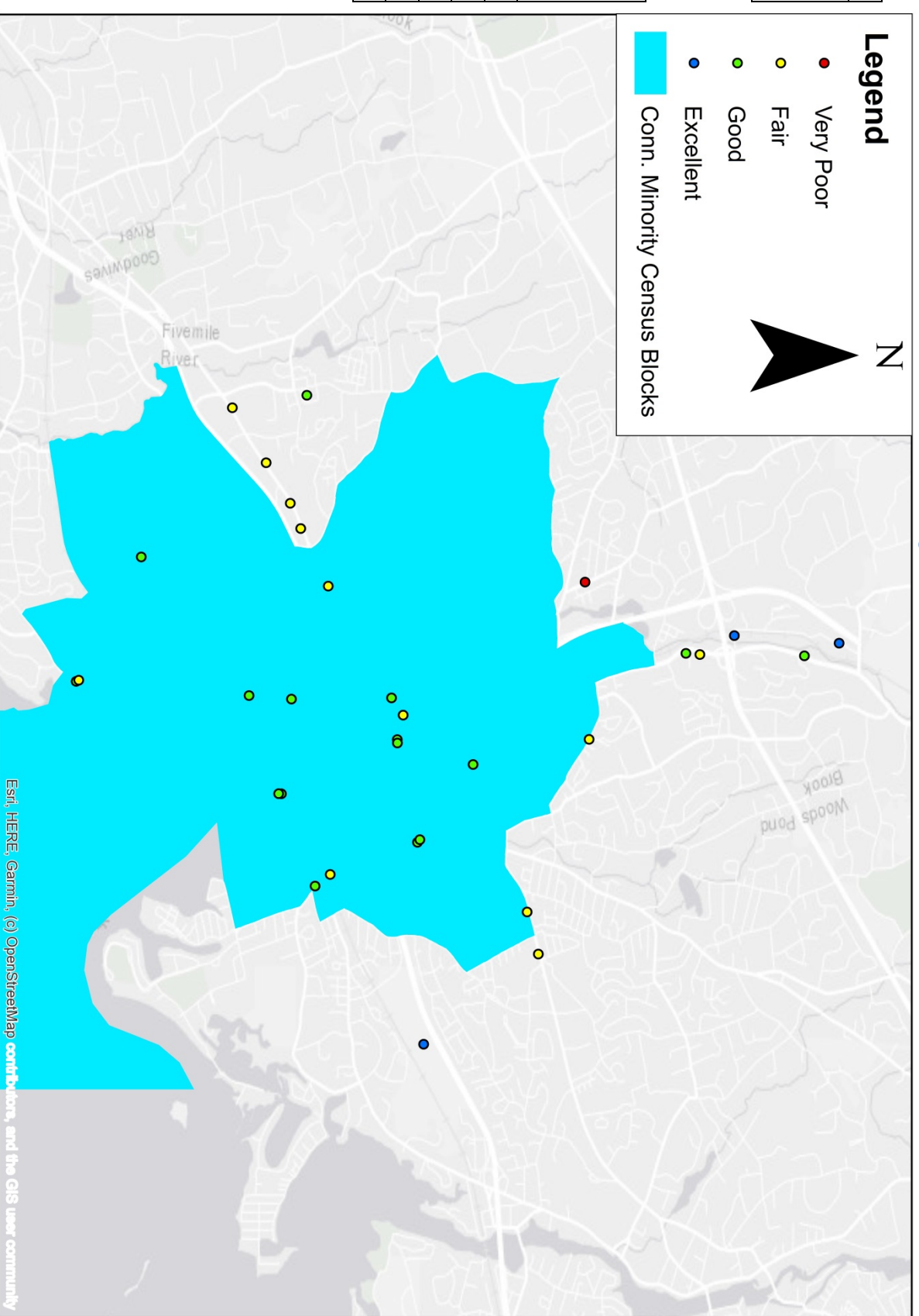


Figure 9-Norwalk Shelter Conditions

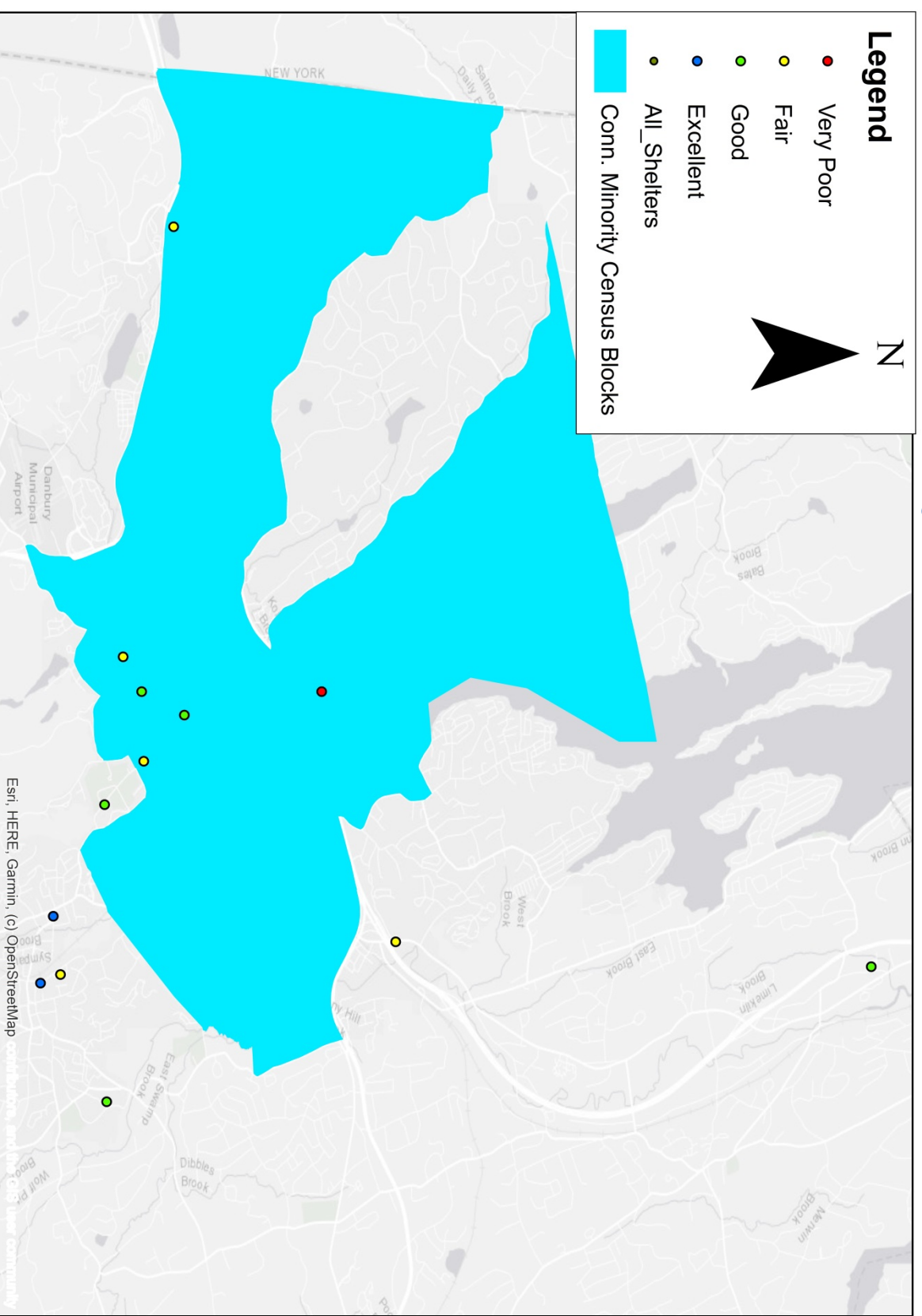


Figure 10-Housatonic Shelter Conditions

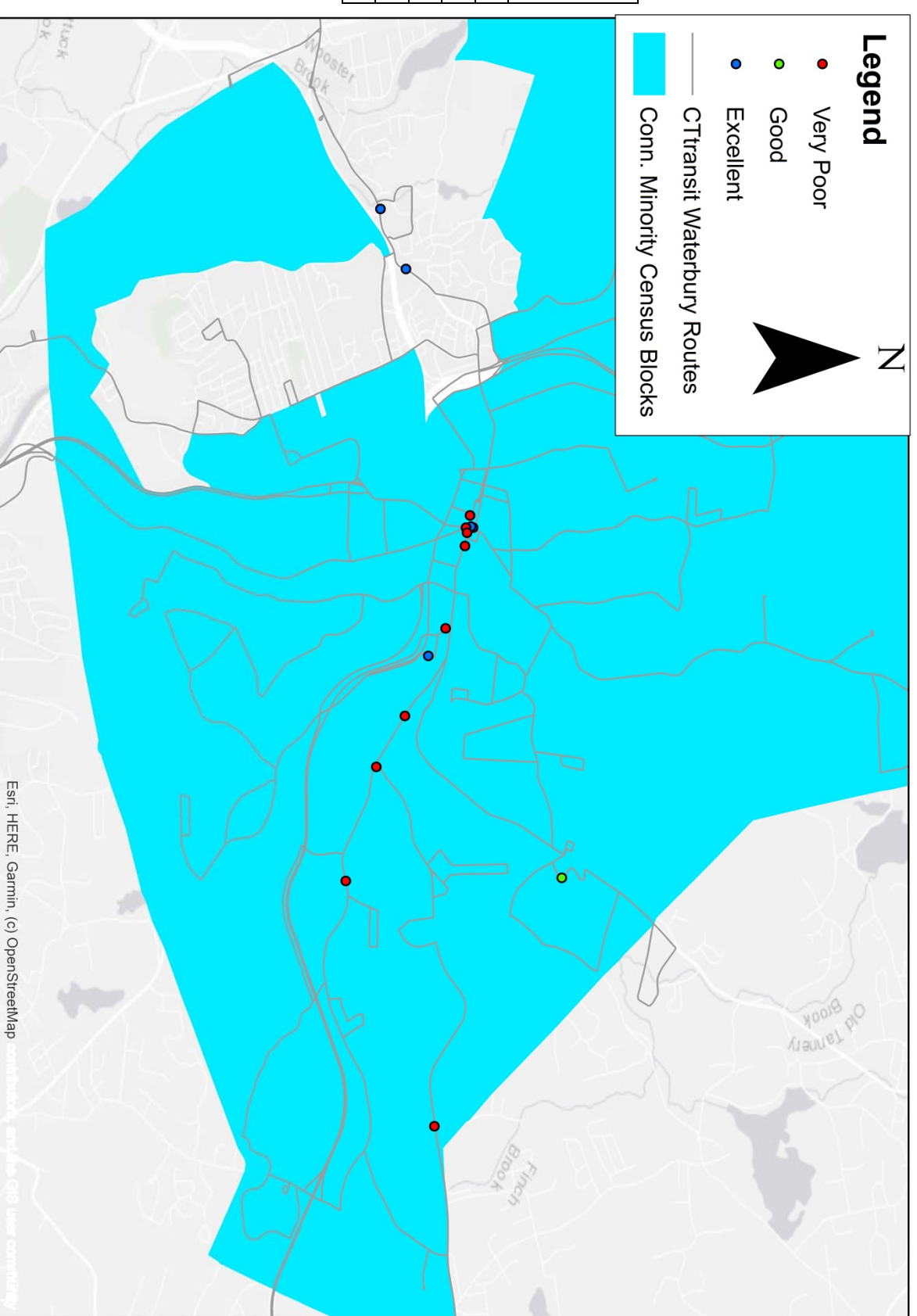


Figure 11-Waterbury Shelter Condition

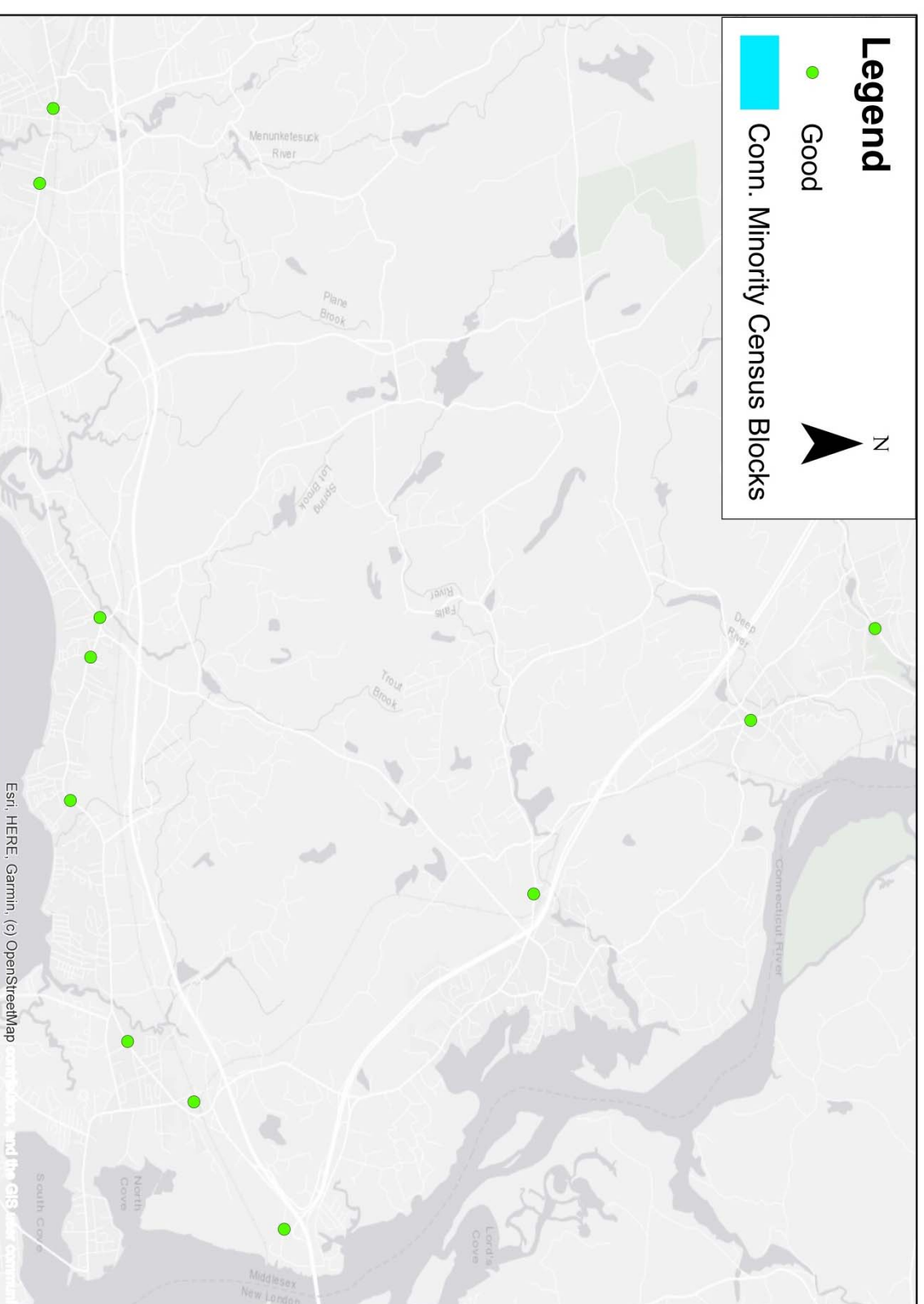


Figure 12-Estuary Shelter Condition

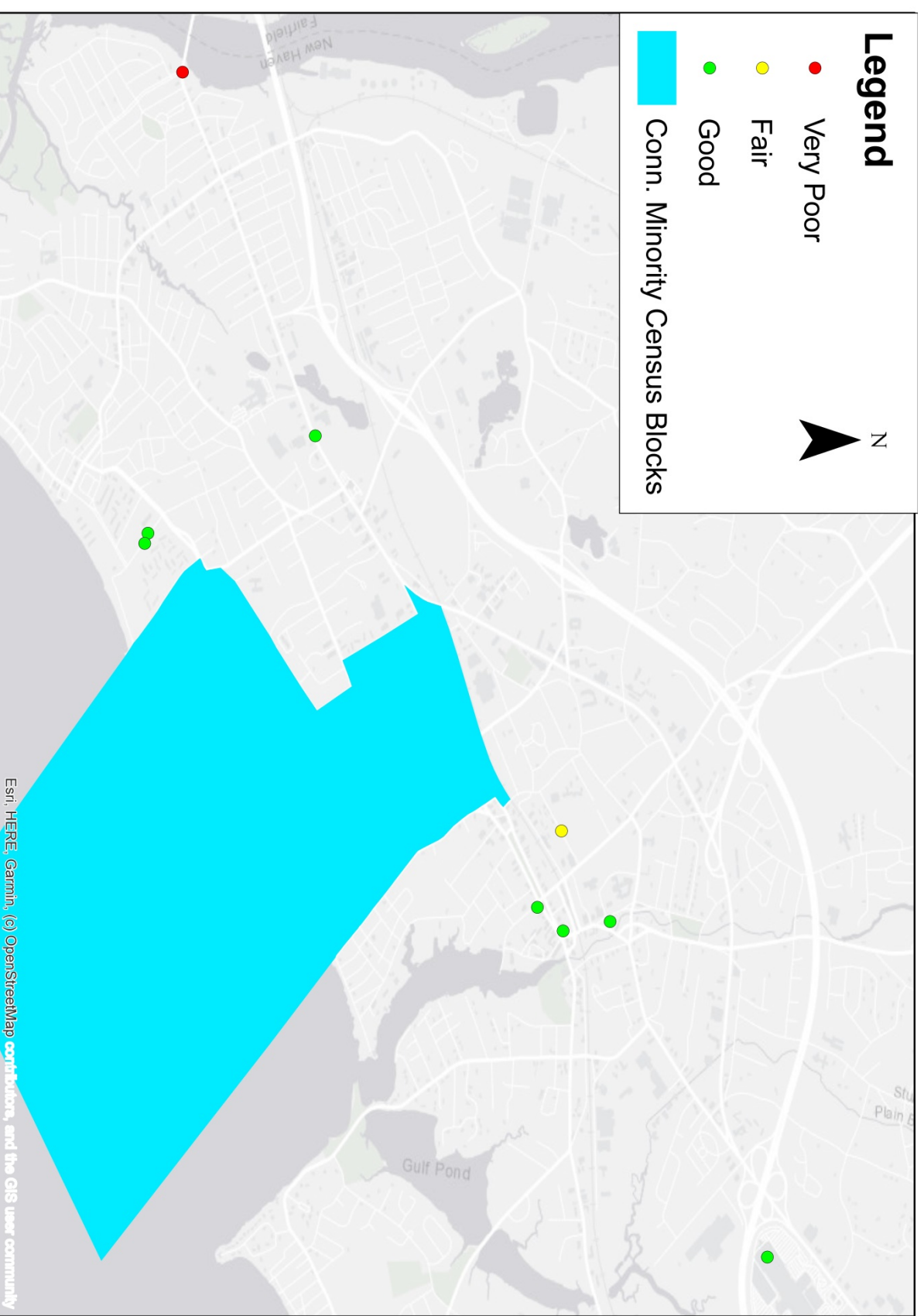

## Financial Overview

This analysis has identified a total of 118 shelters statewide that require replacement. To estimate the cost of the shelters information was gathered from recent installations in the state of Connecticut. The majority of these budgetary figures come from Greater Hartford Transit District and CTtransit. Using these figures it was determined the average cost to install a shelter is approximately \$20,000. Shelter costs can be broken down into the following areas:

1. Concrete Work: Most shelters will require a new pad for the shelter. The cost of the concrete pad can range between \$3,000 to \$5,000. The more work to grade, or connect to existing pedestrian pathways increases the overall cost. This concrete work does not assume any construction of sidewalks, or ADA ramps to crosswalks.
2. Shelter: The shelters most recently purchased by GHTD range from \$6,500 to \$9,200. The shelters purchased by GHTD included a bench. If advertising units are not included, the cost is closer to \$6,500.
3. Shelter options:
  - a. Solar Roof Light-\$1,575
  - b. Solar Advertising Panel-\$1,750
  - c. LED Roof Light-\$375
  - d. LED Advertising Panel-\$475
4. Installation: In most cases a contractor will be used to install the shelter. This will cost between \$3,500 and \$5,000 depending on the complexity of the shelter and any electronics.
5. The above cost does not consider install any new technologies (e.g. real time signs) at the shelter

## Recommendations

### 1. Establish Maintenance Agreement

Transit shelters must remain in a state of good repair for the passengers that utilize them and as a symbol of a well run agency. Ensuring shelters remain in a state of good repair requires routine preventative maintenance, regular cleaning and expedited repair. The broken window theory can be applied to transit shelters, and poor shelter conditions can reflect negatively in the communities in which they are located. If shelters are not repaired quickly, or remain in a state of disrepair, the shelters along the corridor or in abutting communities can also become target of vandalism.

To ensure that shelters remain in a state of good repair a maintenance agreement must be established before any new capital funds are expended. This maintenance agreement can be in the form of an MOU with another entity (e.g. Municipality), or can be adopted into existing practices. Examples of Maintenance programs range in the State, they include direct maintenance by CTDOT, by municipalities, transit districts or are the responsibility of an advertising firm. When installing a new shelter a maintenance agreement should either be developed or the shelters needs to be adopted into existing practices.

### 2. Provided ADA Guidance on any new installation

The state should develop or provide resources on ADA guidance for districts, municipalities or other entities responsible for shelter installation and maintenance. This guidance needs to include information on access to shelter (sidewalk, path, landing pad), slope, and shelter design. While most engineering and design firm for roadway projects are well versed in ADA accessibility, this guidance will provide guidance on proper installation and issues to monitor to long term. Some examples of this guidance are available in appendix 1.

### 3. Establish Statewide Bid to purchase shelters

Transit districts, municipalities and operators for CTDOT would benefit from a Statewide bid to purchase shelters. This process would reduce the burden on districts and municipalities from setting up their own bids, create a standard aesthetic for bus customers (that is also ADA compliant), create a resource for replacement parts, and achieve lower price points than currently achieved. The shelter varieties would need to consider one contemporary and one traditional style shelter. These two base styles are needed given the range of design and aesthetic in the communities around the state. Each style shelter would need to come in smaller size (8' to 10') and a larger size (12 to 16'). In addition to the length these shelters should also be available in a full side wall and a half sidewalk. The half sidewalk is important where there is insufficient space to place a shelter on a sidewalk but protection from the elements are still needed. It is not recommended that the shelters have a panel in front for security reasons. The shelter design should be developed in coordination with transit districts, MPO's and communities.

4. Develop RFI for Transit Technology at Shelters

On street technology has developed significantly over the previous two decades. This technology includes real time arrival signs, ticket vending machines, trip planners, lighting, thermal heating units, etc. As the tech industry develops new opportunities are possible for the shelters and even for the customer. An RFI would provide feedback on the most up to date version of the technology and new possibilities. The RFI would inform the RFP process and options made available for the shelters. The RFI would also need to gather information on power delivery options to the shelters which is a common issue when attempting to deploy technology.

5. Consider Methods to Extend Advertising Opportunities

The authorities that participated in this assessment that use an advertising firms on shelters in the region had better than average shelter conditions. An advertising firm can either directly install or maintain the shelter or they can be used purely as a method to generate revenue. When advertising firms install and maintain, they need to balance agency needs with installation along corridors with high traffic volumes. Advertisers also have an interest in maintaining a state of good repair, as a poorly maintained shelter could reflect badly on the organization or company they are advertising for. When using an advertising firm for shelters a district owns and maintains the revenue typically just offsets the cost of the district. In either case revenue is being generated and shelters are maintained at a higher level.

Given the ability to offset costs and the improved maintenance of the shelter's, consideration for ways to extend advertising should be considered. Some potentials include, creating an RFP template for municipalities to bid directly, consider path through options from operator to communities, have operators directly advertise.

6. Develop on going procedure to document shelter conditions

The condition and updates of shelters should be conducted and reported on an annual basis. Regular tracking and updating inventories ensures that shelters are in a state of good repair, maintenance agreements are being honored and investment can be expended efficiently. CTDOT should consider expanding their existing GIS inventory system for statewide collection of this data. Alternatively, a separate electronic record keeping database could be developed or considered.

## Appendix 1 - ADA Regulations/Reference Material

Bus Boarding and Alighting Areas (810.2.2)

810 Transportation Facilities

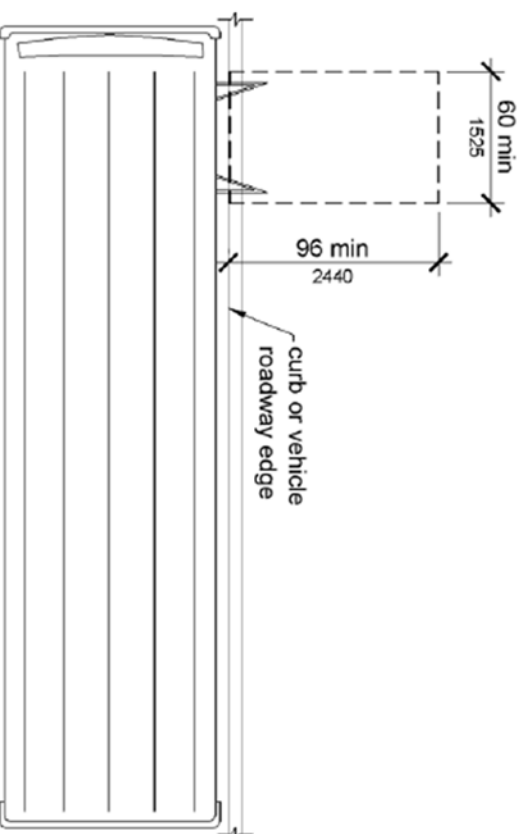
810.1 General. Transportation facilities shall comply with 810.

810.2 Bus Boarding and Alighting Areas. Bus boarding and alighting areas shall comply with 810.2.

Advisory 810.2.2 Bus Boarding and Alighting Areas. At bus stops where a shelter is provided, the bus stop pad can be located either within or outside of the shelter.

810.2.1 Surface. Bus stop boarding and alighting areas shall have a firm, stable surface.

810.2.2 Dimensions. Bus boarding and alighting areas shall provide a clear length of 96 inches (2440 mm), measured perpendicular to the curb or vehicle roadway edge, and a clear width of 60 inches (1525 mm), measured parallel to the vehicle roadway. Public entities shall ensure that the construction of bus boarding and alighting areas comply with 810.2.2, to the extent the construction specifications are within their control.

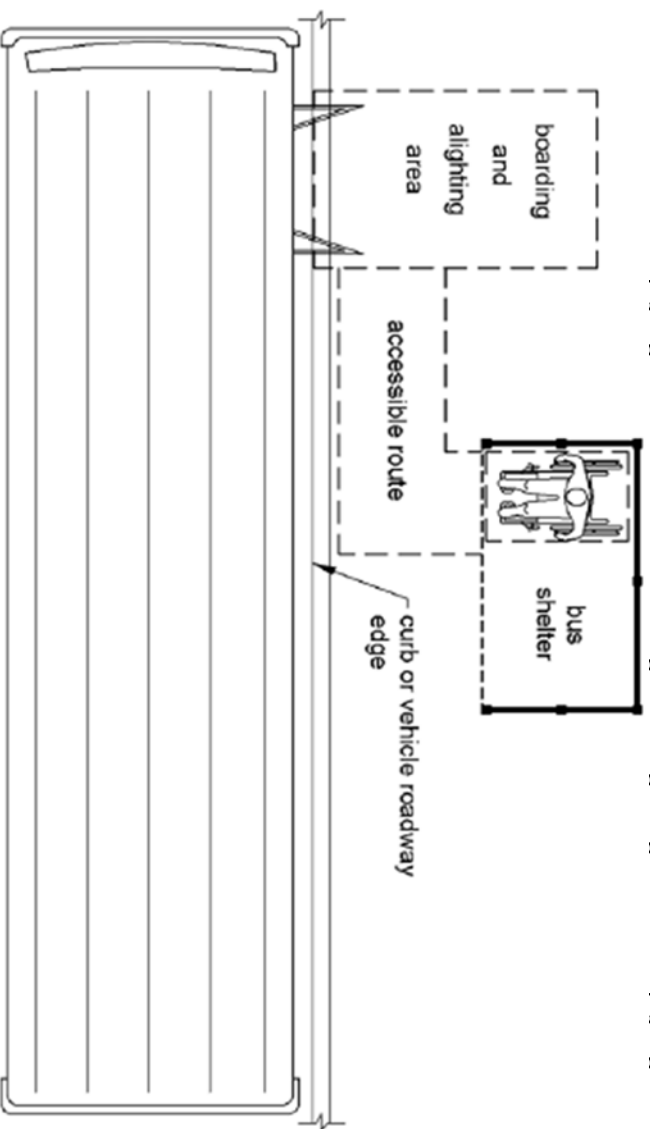


**Figure 810.2.2 Dimensions of Bus Boarding and Alighting Areas**

810.2.3 Connection. Bus stop boarding and alighting areas shall be connected to streets, sidewalks, or pedestrian paths by an accessible route complying with 402.

810.2.4 Slope. Parallel to the roadway, the slope of the bus stop boarding and alighting area shall be the same as the roadway, to the maximum extent practicable. Perpendicular to the roadway, the slope of the bus stop boarding and alighting area shall not be steeper than 1:48.

810.3 Bus Shelters. Bus shelters shall provide a minimum clear floor or ground space complying with 305 entirely within the shelter. Bus shelters shall be connected by an accessible route complying with 402 to a boarding and alighting area complying with 810.2.

810.4 Bus Signs. Bus route identification signs shall comply with 703.5.1 through 703.5.4, and 703.5.7 and 703.5.8. In addition, to the maximum extent practicable, bus route identification signs shall comply with 703.5.5.

**EXCEPTION:** Bus schedules, timetables and maps that are posted at the bus stop or bus bay shall not be required to comply.
