The following questions were submitted to James Rode, Director of Transportation Planning, via email between September 4th, and September 18th, 2024. Please see the answers below each question.

- 1) If a Firm was on the previous On-Call Engineering List for FY21, do they have to reapply?
  - a) Yes, Firms must apply to this RFQ if they want to remain on SCRCOG's On-Call Engineering List.
  
- 2) Could you clarify when the RFQs are due?
  - a) The RFQ is due back at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
  
- 3) Could the lists of services be clarified?
  - a) Yes, the two lists are found in Attachment A and section 3.5 Services Offered, which had slightly different items listed. The items in Attachment A broke out Water Pollution Control into different areas, hence the inclusion of Storm Drainage System and Water Distribution System, which is the area of confusion.
