Mayor Dickinson began the meeting at 12:14 PM.

Minutes of the June 9, 2010 meeting were unanimously adopted on a motion by J. Portley/ FS Freda.

Item #2

J. Rode presented the FY2010 -FY2013 TIP Amendment 8. New projects added to the TIP included 0092-XXXX Route 34 East Downtown Crossing project for the design and construction of the first phase of the conversion of Route 34 East from an expressway to an urban boulevard between I-95 and Park Street. City of New Haven, with ConnDOT participation, is submitting an application to US DOT for TIGER II program funding and funds needed to be included in the TIP prior to grant approval. Project # 0106-0116 West Haven Intermodal Station-FY08 Earmark was added. This action was necessary to allow for the filing of a grant application and to avoid lapsing the funds. J. Portley made the motion to approve FY10 TIP Amendment 8, FS Freda seconded motion was approved.

Item #3

Mayor Dickinson spoke about a letter included in the agenda packet regarding a pavement preservation project in Wallingford. A meeting was held with ConnDOT staff to discuss cost estimates and the use of VIP pricing for pavement. ConnDOT responded with information to explain why FHWA will not allow the use of VIP pricing. J Thompson is reviewing this material and the next step would be a meeting with FHWA for further clarifications.

J. Rode presented the status on current urban projects included in the agenda package. Those present provided additional information on the progress of their individual projects.

Item #5

P Fry spoke about a project underway to update bus stop signage in the region. CTTRANSIT will contact each municipality. D. Carter spoke about the GNHTD bus shelter program and the potential for a regional maintenance program

J. Plaziak made a motion to adjourn meeting, J. Portley seconded. The meeting adjourned at 1:00 PM.

Whereas: U.S. Department of Transportation "Metropolitan Planning Regulations" (23 CFR 450) prescribe that each metropolitan planning organization maintain a financially constrained multi-modal transportation improvement program consistent with a State Implementation Plan for Air Quality (SIP) conforming to both U.S. Environmental Protection Administration-established air quality guidelines and SIP-established mobile source emissions budgets; and

Whereas: The Council, per 23 CFR 450.324 and in cooperation with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT) and public transit operators and relying upon financial constraints offered by ConnDOT, adopted a Fiscal Year 2010-Fiscal Year 2013 Transportation Improvement Program on October 28, 2009, after finding the Program conforming per U.S. Environmental Protection Administration (U.S. EPA) final conformity rule (40 CFR 51 and 93) and relevant Connecticut Department of Transportation air quality conformity determinations: Air Quality Conformity Reports: Fiscal Year 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program and the Region's Long-Range Transportation Plans, May, 2007); and

Whereas: The Council, on October 28, 2009, indicated that periodic *Program* adjustment or amendment was possible; and

Whereas: Projects referenced in the Program amendment (below) are consistent with the region's long-range transportation plan (South Central Regional Long Range Transportation Plan—2007 to 2035, (May, 2007); and

Whereas: Council Public Participation Guidelines: Transportation Planning have been observed during the development of the proposed Program amendment (below); and

Whereas: By agreement between the Council and the Connecticut Department of Transportation, public involvement activities carried out by the South Central Regional Council of Governments in response to U.S. Department of Transportation metropolitan planning requirements are intended to satisfy the requirements associated with development of a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program and/or its amendment; and

Whereas: Council of Governments' review of transportation goals, projects and opportunities may result in further adjustment or amendment of the *Program*.
